Greetings, fellow KCCD Members and supporters! This year has been very challenging for our KCCD state board. We entered 2020 anxious to plan our 61st annual training conference only to be met head-on with a pandemic that would deem it unsafe for us to come together as we do each September. So, as a board, we had to get creative on how to do our annual business meeting.

Our annual business meeting will begin on Monday, August 31, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. EST via Zoom at <https://zoom.us/j/94296567948?pwd=RIJxWW5Mc3Noamx6cjZXWFFnQTlYQT09>. During our business meeting, we will have our chapter presidents present their year in review, ask for nominations from the membership for state board officers and board of directors, and then discuss the election process.

KCCD elections will be held online this year. Members will have ample time to cast their vote. Voting will begin at 6:00 a.m. EST on Tuesday, September 1, 2020, and end at 6:00 p.m. EST on Thursday, September 3, 2020. All voters will be screened to ensure membership is active, and if not, your vote will not count. The link to vote will be emailed to all members with an email address on file as well as be made available to your Chapter President once online voting is launched. If you do not choose to vote online, members may request an absentee ballot, available via our website at www.kccdonline.com. All absentee ballots must be postmarked by August 24, 2020. If you submit an absentee ballot, but then decide to vote online, you will need to contact President David Bradley via email at davidb.bradley@ky.gov, prior to the count of the votes, to let him know that you wish to cast your vote online and to destroy your absentee ballot. Failure to contact President Bradley and proceeding with voting online will void both methods of voting.

The closing of the annual business meeting will be scheduled for Friday, September 4, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. EST via Zoom at <https://zoom.us/j/93797973864?pwd=a01LV2dnM3UwWHN2VTYxTjMvYXV2dz09>, where we will be making the announcement of our 2020-2021 state board officers and board of directors, winners of our annual KCCD awards, and then officially close the annual meeting.

Prior to our scheduled annual business meeting, we ask that you pay your annual membership dues online via our website at www.kccdonline.com or through your chapter president. Your membership must be active to participate in the voting process.

We look forward to you joining us virtually for our annual business meeting and regret that we cannot meet in person this year. Please continue to stay safe and healthy!
